ITEM I. INVOCATION:

The invocation was given by Councilmember Steve Highfield.

ITEM II. RECOGNIZE EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH:

ITEM IV. VISITORS/CITIZENS FORUM:

Davina Douglas told the council that the Love Your Community Development Corporation had recently received its non-profit status and would begin working to fill gaps in the community. Love your Community is an organization motivated to build a strong, healthy, prosperous, and spiritual community empowered and committed to changing quality of life by demonstrating love to our neighbors.

1. Councilmember Bill Harris made the motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting December 3, 2018.

ITEM VI. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Discussion with Curtiss Jackson regarding Avenue W and Memorial Way. – Curtiss Jackson asked the council if the City had been able to get an answer as to what would be done about an unpaved portion of Avenue W. Avenue W runs along the east side of Jacksons property. The city sent a letter to the developer, Travis Wisdom, about paving the portion of Avenue W and failed to receive a response. According to the city's ordinance related to subdivisions, developers are required to install curbs and gutters and to pave roads. City Attorney Bryan Guymon stated the situation is a civil matter between Jackson and the developer Travis Wisdom.
2. Councilmember Luann Burleson made the motion to appoint Freddie Mena to the Builders Board of Appeal board.

The motion was seconded by Councilmember Steve Rich and passed with the following vote:

3. Councilmember Luann Burleson made the motion to approve Resolution R190107 appointing two new Board of Directors to the Tax Increment Financing Reinvestment Zone Number one and appointing one member of the board to serve as chairman as captioned below:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SNYDER, TEXAS, APPOINTING TWO NEW MEMBERS TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TAX INCREMENT FINANCING REINVESTMENT ZONE NUMBER ONE (TIF #1), CITY OF SNYDER, TEXAS, APPOINTING ONE MEMBER OF THE BOARD TO SERVE AS CHAIRMAN, AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATING TO SUCH BOARD.

The motion was seconded by Councilmember Steve Highfield and passed with the following vote:

The following Board of Director members were selected: Vernon Clay and Duane Summers (contingent upon agreeing, if not Dr. Berry Jordan will serve).

Brooke Proctor was appointed Chairman of the Board of Directors.


