ITEM V. OLD BUSINESS:

1. Councilmember Sarah Jamison made the motion to adopt on second reading Ordinance No. 2130 repealing and replacing Article 3.02 of the Snyder Code of Ordinances by adopting the 2021 International Building Code and 2023 National Electrical Code as captioned below:

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REPLACING ARTICLE 3.02 OF THE CITY OF SNYDER CODE OF ORDINANCES, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AMENDING THESE SECTIONS BY ADOPTING THE 2021 EDITIONS OF THE INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE, INTERNATIONAL RESIDENTIAL CODE FOR ONE-AND TWO-FAMILY DWELLINGS, INTERNATIONAL PLUMBING CODE,

INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE, INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE, INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE, INTERNATIONAL EXISTING BUILDING CODE, INTERNATIONAL SWIMMING POOL AND SPA CODE, INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE, AND THE 2023 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

2. Councilmember Jerry Webb made the motion to adopt on second reading Ordinance No. 2131 amending various sections of Chapter 3, Building Regulations, Article 3.09, Cross-Connection Control Program as captioned below:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 3, BUILDING REGULATIONS, ARTICLE 3.09, CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL PROGRAM, TO UPDATE SAID SECTIONS TO BE CONSISTENT WITH APPLICABLE LAW; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
